We would like to thank you for your support so far during your child's examination season.

Year 11 students have conducted themselves in an excellent manner for their exams and we fully expect a Summer of success ahead. We look forward to seeing smiles and stories of where students will go after JQA on our Results Day on Thursday 25th August 2022. More details will be released shortly of the timings of this day.

From Monday 20th June, we are amending the Year 11 timetable so that students can spend more time revising from home and be guided remotely ahead of their Physics exam, before returning to site to complete exams and take part in enrichment activities. A link to a Teams group for this is below:

- Monday 20th June: All students arrive in full uniform for 8.15 for a Chemistry Masterclass led by Mr Dowe. Chemistry exam begins at 9.00. Students will be dismissed home between 10.15 and 10.30.
- **Tuesday 21st June:** Remote Assembly via a 'Year 11' Teams group at 8.35 and then a 2 hour remote Physics revision session led by Mr Dowe from 10.30-12.30, then independent revision set to be completed from home. Students sitting the Hospitality and Catering exam should arrive between 13.00-13.15 to start the exam at 13.30.
- Wednesday 22nd June: <u>Remote Assembly via a 'Year 11' Teams group at 8.35 and</u> <u>then a 2 hour remote Physics revision session led by Mr Dowe from 10.30-12.30</u>, then independent revision set to be completed from home.
- **Thursday 23rd June**: All students arrive in full uniform for 8.15 for a Physics Masterclass led by Mr Dowe. Chemistry exam begins at 9.00. Students will be dismissed home between 10.15 and 10.30.
- Friday 24th June non school uniform: Arrive between 8.45-9.00 to have an assembly with Miss Ivey. The day will feature a range of activities around transitioning to Post-16. Students will be dismissed between 14.10-14.20 from the Pope St entrance.
