As you will be aware, Year 10 students have their first opportunity to experience 'mock' exams from w/c 6th June.

These assessments are an important event in the Year 10 calendar which will allow students the opportunity to sample real exam conditions for the first time which will be in place in Summer 2023.

The examinations will be only on content that has been taught in the course so far and will inform future teaching in Year 11.

Each student will be provided with a timetable detailing what dates specific examinations will take place on and they have had an assembly outlining the expectations of public exams which is similar to the expectations of excellence we have shared with our current Year 11 students.
