



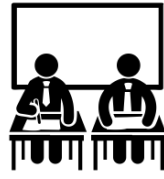

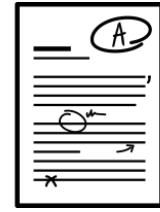

Students will be equipped to confidently explore four themes and apply religious attitudes towards them confidently

Students begin the AQA GCSE Religious studies full course as a option. Year 10 and 11 journey explores the beliefs and practices mainly within Christianity and Islam.

Key understanding of direct religious teaching and arguments. Developing reasoning. During year 9 students will be able to compare ideas or have discursive debate.

Students will have studied wars and conflicts in other subjects, however, they are unlikely to have considered religious teachings regarding war, conflict and peace. This builds on from the previous topic in Year 8 of evil and suffering. Peace and conflict unit aids understanding of History in Year 9 which focuses on the World Wars and Holocaust.

Considering religious viewpoints/ Developing reasoning/ Comparing ideas or having a discursive debate. Environmental issues and stewardship, and the treatment of animals will be studied in greater depth in KS4. Students likely to have an initial response, which they need to be encouraged to consider and develop in detail.

In year 8 students develop key understanding of direct religious teaching and arguments that link to concepts that will be studied in greater depth in year 10 and 11.

The initial cycle of Year 7 is to build on key knowledge and content learnt from primary school.

Methods of worship and key beliefs creates a solid foundation which will be studied in greater depth in Yr10 and Yr11 with Christian Beliefs and Muslim Beliefs topics.
