Continuing To Combat The 'Omicron' Variant of Covid-19 Over The Holidays

On Friday, my team will issue additional lateral flow testing kits to all students so the Sunday/Wednesday rhythm of testing can be followed over the holidays. This is particularly important if seeing elderly relatives as the data suggests they are more likely to be at risk. Children aged 12-15 can also book their 'booster' vaccination from Monday 20th December 2021 <u>via the NHS website</u> and many staff at JQA have already had their 3rd jab to protect themselves and others.

Free School Meals Vouchers

We will be issuing vouchers for families eligible for free school meals to cover the duration of the Christmas holidays. Parents/carers will receive a link to a voucher, valued at £30, via the email address they have provided to the Academy. Our reception is closed over the holidays so any enquiries of this nature should be received via telephone before 1pm on Friday 17th December.
