This week saw a range of activities to continue our commitment to being a Beacon School for Holocaust Education. We are proud of this as it is central to our value of 'respect' and our wonderful students have engaged with the Echo Eternal Horizons 21 festival in so many ways. We are very proud of the contributions they have made to the 23 day festival.

This nationally-recognised programme always centres around learning lessons from one of humanity's darkest hours. Our <u>pledge of 'Don't Hate', inspired by our survivor's testimony (Zigi Shipper), is a message we embrace and encourage.</u> Students have been exploring this message and other aspects of learning from the Holocaust in Personal Development sessions throughout January with theme of 'being the light in darkness'. Our students have been moved to feel compassion, found humility in the gift of testimony and have used their artistry to pay tribute to the testimony of survivors. Thursday night sees our echo being projected onto the side of JQA which promises to be a very moving event.

Live lessons continue to spark students' learning as we remain at home and our expert staff have been working hard to ensure our students have the best quality lessons. Led by the senior team, our staff are becoming ever more accomplished at delivering live learning as we progress into the Spring Term and this is reflected in our strong attendance to live lessons which continues to get higher and higher week on week.. # OPPORTUNITY - Echo Eternal

Wednesday 27th January represents the Holocaust Memorial Day. It is a commemoration day dedicated to the remembrance of those who suffered in the Holocaust under Nazi persecution and in subsequent genocides in Cambodia, Rwanda, Bosnia, and Darfur.

There is usually a national event that brings together survivors, their families, celebrities and members of the Royal Family to mark the day.

Due to the national lockdown, events were streamed for people to watch online. There are national events as well as various local events taking place up and down the UK. Most can be watched live via social media or YouTube and you may have seen various buildings bathed in purple light to mark this.


The theme for Holocaust Memorial Day 2021 is "be the light in the darkness" to encourage everyone to reflect on the depths humanity can sink to as well as the ways individuals and communities resisted that darkness to "be the light" before, during and after genocide.

#### A Message from our Teaching Assistants

At Jewellery Quarter Academy, we know how important it is to support and provide equal opportunities for all of our students. We have adapted and allocated lots of strategies and resources that aid our SEND and EAL students and we are currently providing live interventions, via Teams, during the current lock-down.

At the moment, our SEND department consists of 2 teaching assistants: Miss Tate and Miss Hricikova, who work closely with students, across all year groups either on a 1:1 or group basis.

We plan and deliver personalised sessions for students who require extra support in literacy and numeracy, or have specific learning and individualised needs.

The main aim and focus of our sessions is to enhance students' understanding of certain topics and skills to progress their learning further and to ensure any gaps in knowledge are closed.

We work closely with the SENDCo Miss Lowbridge, and we continue to receive unique and targeted training based on the needs of our individual students.

### **RESPECT**– Guide to Remote Learning

#### Helping Your Child To Succeed in Virtual JQA

Firstly, thank you for your support with remote learning this term. We recognise the challenges for families around this and want to thank you first and foremost for working with us to support your child. Whether that means supporting with technology or checking in with you via telephone to see if we can help in any way, we feel it's important to all work together to ensure our children's success.

Virtual JQA lessons are delivered live by your child's regular teacher. The format of the lesson follows the same structure which your child is very much used to. The first half is 'delivery' which can include group work, discussion and questioning—your child will respond in the 'chat'.

The second half of the lesson is when your child should independently complete their assignment on Teams. During this time, their teacher will 'watch' as they are working, giving them live verbal and written feedback.

We have put together <u>7 key tips</u> for parents ands carers to support their child:

- **Rise and Shine**—have a regular morning and bedtime routine to ensure they are up and ready to learn online at 0830.
- **Headphones and device charge**—make sure your child gets into the routine of being ready with devices charged and headphones, if they are used, able to be located easily
- Know your child's timetable—you may have written it out on a piece of paper and stuck it up somewhere central in the house: this will help you all to know what's coming up
- **Ensure engagement**—check in with your child regularly throughout the day. A question might be: what have you posted in the chat so far? Or...Show me your assignment task for this lesson.
- Clarify and check—check what assignments they have to do and what the deadlines are
- Screen breaks—ensure your child uses their screen breaks and lunch time to come away from the device and also
- **Pen and paper**—your child might want to take notes during delivery of learning

#### Please provide your child with a quiet, comfortable space to work in.

If any of these things are an issue, then please contact the academy and we will do our best to support you and your child while they continue to learn from home.





There are many myths about the vaccine, spread by fake news, and this is giving doubts to many people. The diagram to the right gives clear facts about the vaccine.


