Spring Term Impact

- 600+ on roll waiting lists in some year groups
- Hatch converted to outside eating space
- Successful bid for re-furbishment of 2 new computer rooms.
- 99 new laptops to be booked out during curriculum time
- 10k spent on books (classics/BAME authors prioritised) and Little Libraries installed
- Every child given the opportunity to be a member of Birmingham Libraries
- Guided reading in form time 3 times a week every student reads for an hour now
- Removed the one way system after consulting Student Parliament
- Year 7 swimming badges at Ladywood Leisure Centre
- Students representing JQA as flag-bearers at the opening of the Commonwealth Games
- FREE breakfast provision so every child can eat before school if they wish



Spring Term Impact

- Trip to Globe Theatre so Year 9/10 students can watch a Shakespeare play
- Expanded extra-curricular provision
- Partnership with First Class Foundations to ensure safe travel home after school in dark nights
- Debate Mate to help students to articulate arguments
- Brilliant Club began for our high potential students
- Coachbright supporting our students to catch up with tutoring
- Police partnership security arch (routine each term)
- Full homework timetable for all years and Home Learning support on the app
- Reading Plus started for Year 7 students
- 50+ cases of legal intervention and 2 court cases over attendance
- The return of competitive sport and the CORE Games (in new kits!)
- Successful 2nd Year 11 mocks on site and all Year 11 receiving 1 to 1 careers advice and guidance
- Responded and adapted to new Covid measures safely
- Study space for Year 11 and reflection area during Ramadan
